The varied Japanese menu is packed with all the favourites including fresh salted edamame, \$6, and agedashi tofu, \$7, as well as some delicious new alternatives. The oxtail tortellini, \$18, with seared scallops, oxtail and wasabi jus an absolute favourite and one not to be missed. Of course, we couldn't resist the small assorted sashimi, \$19, and large sushi selection, \$36, topped with sesame dressing and basil sauce.
